



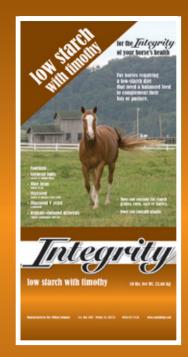

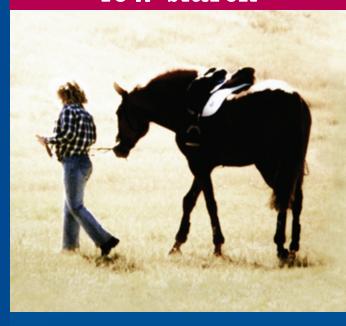

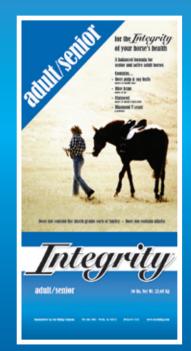
## Horse's Activity Level **Suggested Feeding Guidelines**

**Growing Horse** 

Introduce at 8 -10 months of age; can be fed up to 3 - 4 years of age 1/2 lb. up to 1 lb. per 100 lbs. of horse's body weight fed daily with a quality forage; younger horses require more feed during faster growth periods compared to older growing horses

3 years and older

Feed one of the Ace Hi or Kellev's brand performance feeds, or Integrity Adult/Senior

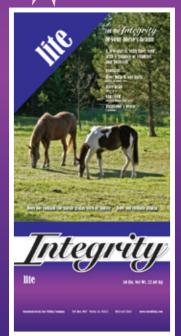

Overweight Horses	Integrity Lite is lower in starch and higher in fiber; consult with your veterinarian for appropriate qtys.
Cushing, HYPP	Integrity Lite is lower in starch and

higher in fiber; consult with your
